

Installing Windows Marketplace for Mobile on your Windows Mobile 6.0 or Windows Mobile 6.1 phone

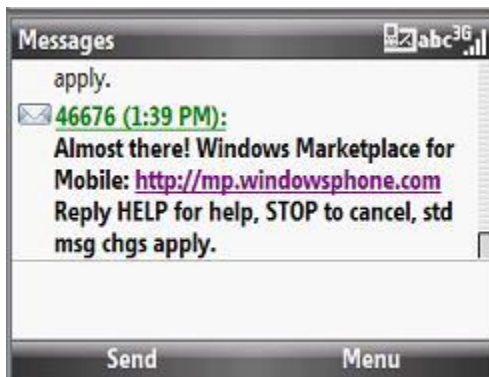
If you have a phone running Windows Mobile 6.0 or Windows Mobile 6.1, you must download and install the Windows Marketplace for Mobile software to use the program on your phone.

Download Windows Marketplace for Mobile

1. Go to the [Download Windows Marketplace for Mobile](#) page. In the text entry box, enter the phone number of the phone that you want to install the Marketplace software on. This phone number will be used to send a Short Message Service (SMS) message that will take you to the installation steps for the Marketplace program.

Note There will be two installation packages: one that loads a .cab file to your phone and one that you'll use the first time you start the Marketplace software from the **Start** menu on your phone.

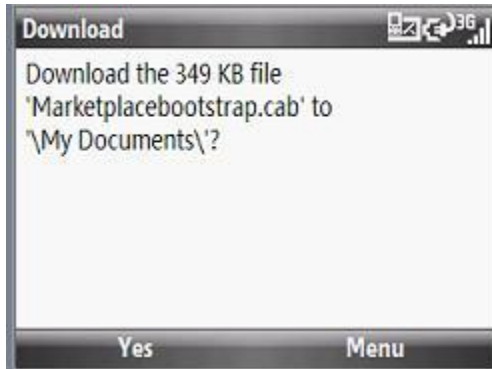
2. You'll receive the following text message on your phone. Tap the link in the message.



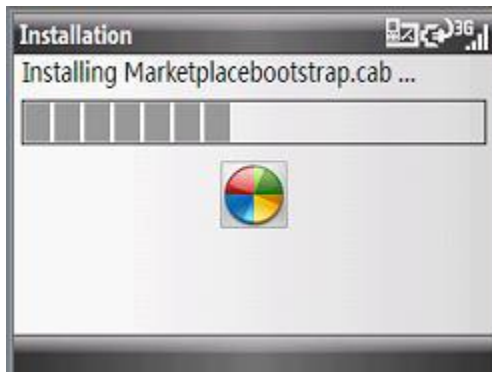
3. On the Windows Marketplace for Mobile page, tap **Download Windows Marketplace for Mobile**.



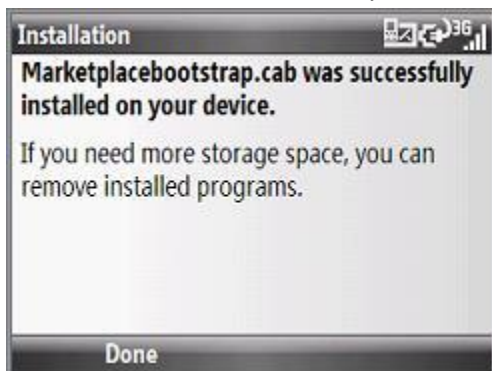
- When you are prompted to select a location to put the .cab file on your phone, tap **Yes**, or tap **Menu** to save the file to another location.



You will then see a screen or a series of screens showing the progress of the installation.



- After the .cab file is successfully installed, you will see the following message. Tap **Done**.



Install and set up Marketplace for Mobile

The first time you start Marketplace, you have to go through a short series of setup steps to complete the installation:

1. To install and set up the Marketplace program, tap **Start > Marketplace**, or, on some phones, tap **Start > Programs files > Marketplace**.



2. When asked if you would like to download and install Marketplace, tap **Yes**.



You will see the installation progress as the software is installed.



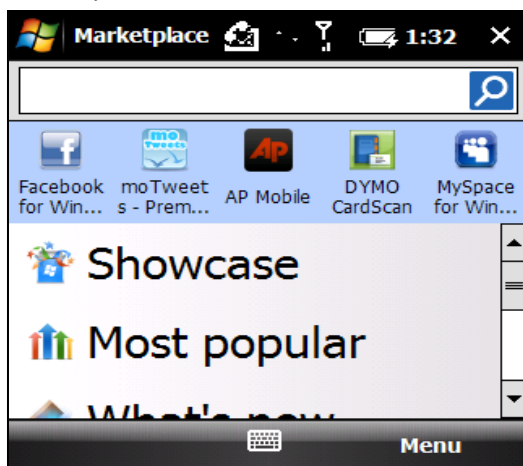
3. Tap **Accept** to accept the customer agreement and privacy policy.



You will see a check screen. This check ensures that the most recent version of the software is running on your phone.



4. When the check finishes, the Marketplace home screen appears, and you can begin using Marketplace.



5. Tap **Menu > Sign in** to sign in using your Windows Live ID. You must sign in to download applications.
